



## Common Terms in SIRIS

Below are terms that you will frequently see in SIRIS, especially as search criteria. <b>Academic Group</b>	Academic Group is a structure used to group Academic Programs and Subject Codes by Schools and other program-administering organizations.
<b>Acad-Prof Degree Type</b>	The Acad-Prof Degree Type identifies whether a given Degree is an Academic Degree or a Professional Degree.
<b>Academic Term Last Enrollment Status Long Description</b>	The Academic Term Last Enrollment Status Long Description is a textual representation of an Academic Term Last Enrollment Status, which is the latest recorded academic enrollment status of a given Student for a given Academic Term, i.e., the current status during an Academic Term, or the final status of a previous Academic Term.
<b>Academic Term Last Program Status Long Description</b>	The Academic Term Last Program Status Long Description is a textual representation of an Academic Term Last Program Status, which is the latest recorded status of an Academic Program for a student during a given Academic Term, or the final program status of a previous Academic Term.
<b>B-M-D Degree Level</b>	The B-M-D Degree Level identifies whether a given Degree is classified as a Bachelor's Degree, a Master's Degree, or a Doctoral Degree.
<b>Catalog Number</b>	Course Offering Catalog Number Text is an alphanumeric identifier which is paired with a Course Offering Subject Code in order to identify a Course Offering.
<b>Class Acad Career</b>	The Class Academic Career Code is the Academic Career Code assigned to a particular Class Section.



## Common Terms in SIRIS (continued)

<b>Class Component</b>	A Class Component provides information about (a wide variety of assorted) characteristics of a Class Section. Some Course Offerings may have multiple Class Sections, each with a different Class Component, such as a lecture and discussion section.
<b>Class ID Number</b>	A Class Section ID is a multi-digit numeric identifier automatically assigned to each Class Section by the Peoplesoft system. Class Section IDs are unique within terms or sessions, but they can also be reused from term to term and are not consistent across terms.
<b>Class Section Number</b>	Class Section Number is a two-digit number, assigned by the Peoplesoft system, which helps differentiate multiple Class Sections that are offered in the same term or session.
<b>Course ID</b>	A Course ID is a unique numeric identifier of a Course, automatically assigned by PeopleSoft.
<b>Course Offering Nbr</b>	A Course Offering Number uniquely identifies each Course Offering associated with a single Course. Course Offering Numbers are automatically assigned by PeopleSoft.
<b>Crosslisted Classes</b>	A Crosslisted Class, sometimes also referred to as a Crosslisted Course, is a class in which all the students are attending together and are being taught by the same instructor(s) but have enrolled under different Course Offering Subjects and/or Course Offering Catalog Numbers.
<b>Degree Code</b>	Degree Code represents a given Degree, which is a certification that a given program of academic study has been successfully completed.
<b>Individualized Classes</b>	Individualized Classes comprise of Class Sections of Class Component type 'INS' (Independent Study), 'T/D' (Thesis/Dissertation), and 'CLK' (Clerkship). All others are 'Regular' classes.
<b>Regular Classes</b>	Regular Classes are all classes with Class Component other than 'INS' (Independent Study), 'T/D' (Thesis/Dissertation), and 'CLK' (Clerkship).



### Common Terms in SIRIS (continued)

<b>Term Code</b>	An Academic Term Code is a standard identifier representing a given Academic Term, which is a subdivision of an Academic Year that establishes the time period for core academic activities, such as when most courses are offered and taken, degrees are conferred, etc.
<b>Session</b>	An Academic Session is a period of time that falls within, and is potentially shorter than, an Academic Term which is the basis for scheduling courses, programs, or other academic Activities.
<b>Subject</b>	A Course Offering Subject usually represents a domain of study offered by an Academic Org but in some cases identifies a curricular category, such as courses taught in Thinking Matters or in a particular overseas location.
<b>Summer Start Academic Year</b>	The Summer Start Academic Year is a roughly calendar-year-length (12-month) period, beginning with summer term, and ending with the following spring term. It is used primarily for reporting on degrees conferred.

### Course, Course Offering, and Class/Section

<b>Course</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Abstract level of a course.</li> <li>● Course title and six-digit course ID is set.</li> </ul>
<b>Course Offering</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Assigned when an organization decides to offer a course.</li> <li>● Subject and catalog number for a course are set.</li> <li>● Multiple course offerings for the same course are known as crosslistings.</li> </ul>
<b>Class/Section</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Physical instances of a course offering.</li> <li>● Inherits information from course and course offering.</li> <li>● Have student enrollment, meeting time and location, instructors, academic career, and grading basis.</li> </ul>
